

Region 4 Mobile Crisis Responder (MCR) Training Overview & Expectations

Why Mobile Crisis Responder Training?

To equip mobile crisis and community-based stabilization staff with the skills, competencies and knowledge necessary to successfully provide mobile crisis and community-based stabilization services.

Who is eligible to be trained?

All current mobile crisis private providers who have a signed MOU with Region 4.

In order to successfully complete the training, participants will need to:

- Complete each pre-test (6 total)
- Complete the pre and post work for each of the 6 courses
- Complete each post-test (6 total)

MCR Participant and Trainer Expectations:

Training Overview:

- Each curriculum (Youth and Adult) are 36 hours total of direct instruction, split into 6 modules. A hybrid option will be available for participants who need to be trained in both.
- Each module will be assigned in the online learning management system
- Pre-work is approximately 2-3 hours per module
- Post-work is approximately 1-2 hours per module

Participant Expectations:

- When on Zoom, it is mandatory for participants to have cameras on
- Participants will actively engage in Zoom breakout room activities
- The pre-work and pre-test are completed before the start of each module
- The post-test will be assigned immediately upon completing the content and trainers will give time at the end of the module for participants to complete/pass the test that same day. This ensures participants are prepared to start the next module.
